The Devil's Needle was considered one of the 15 best climbs in the world, both for the beauty of its formation and for the adventure of the venture. Located in the heart of the park, this mountain is also known for its difficult access requiring good logistics and physical conditioning. The best and most rewarding strategy for this work is 2 days: 1 day for approach (14 km) and preparation, and another for climbing and return. We camped in a small clearing at the bottom of the Paquequer valley, a rare and preserved place. At night, the temperature usually drops a lot and due to humidity, a good sleeping bag is imperative.

ITINERARY 2 | AGULHA DO DIABO 2 DAYS

1ST DAY

- 5:00** Pick up at the hotel or address in RJ
- 7:00** Transfer to the Serra dos Órgãos National Park - Headquarters of Teresópolis



7:15 Beginning of the walk

Stop at " Abrigo 3 " for rest (7 km)

Entrance to the Paquequer Valley (Cota 2000)

Assembly of the camp

Lunch

14:00 Climb to the belvedere of hell to see the Needle of the Devil. Porteio of equipment

17:00 Return to camp and rest

18:00 Dinner

2ND DAY

5:00 Breakfast

6:00 Beginning of the trail

Descent from the Grotto

8:00 Track base - Equipment and check

Nail Chimney Plateau

Summit – 2.050m

Starting the descente

Return trip to the camp

Disassembling the camp

16:00 Walk downhill (12 km)

19:00 Transfer back to the point of origin



RECOMMENDATIONS

We recommend that the participant take a small backpack with personal belongings, camera, water (1 to 2 liters per person) and some energy food such as nuts and dried fruits

REQUIREMENTS / RESTRICTIONS

- For guided climbing it is necessary to have previous experience and to know how to perform the basic safety procedures, to mount the brake and to descend from abseiling.
- It is necessary that the participant be physically fit for physical activities. If in doubt consult a doctor
